each tray weighing approx 10lbs**

LOTS

- 1 Cox's Orange Pippin – Deliciously sweet with subtle acidity and rich intense aromatic flavour
- 2 Crispin – Sweet, crisp and juicy, the perfect apple for Tart Tatin
- 3 Malling Kent - Also raised in Kent, Firm, with a sweet nutty flavour
- 4 Red Pippin—This Kent bred apple is Rich, quite sweet and refreshingly tangy
- 5 Jonagored – This large apple is Crisp sweet and very juicy
- 6 Windsor - Popular early apple juicy and slightly sharp
- 7 Golden Smoothie – Sweet, crisp and juicy, an ideal apple for toffee apples
- 8 Jupiter – Raised in Kent, crisp and juicy with Cox like flavour
- 9 Idared – Pretty apple crisp and sweet and keeps well until April May
- 10 Granny Smith - Granny Smith herself was born in Peasmarsh in 1800 before emigrating to New Zealand and growing this famous apple
- 11 Egremont Russet – First recorded in 1872 possibly from Sussex. Sweet, rich, nutty flavour

- 12 Bramley Seedling - King of the cookers
- 13 Royal Gala – Very popular variety crisp, sweet and juicy
- 14 Mairi Red – A new variety very crisp, sweet and stores very well tasting best after January
- 15 Fuji - Raised in 1939 crisp firm and quite juicy
- 16 Braeburn – now grown quite widely in the UK, more crisp than the imported apples
- 17 Crowngold – Large beautiful apple, crisp, sweet and juicy, delicious baked whole or just eaten fresh
- 18 Adams Pearmain – Dry nutty flavour an old English dessert apple brought to notice in 1826
- 19 Cheerful Gold—a new variety bred at Staplehurst. Crisp, fragrant and keeps well.
- 20 Falstaff – Raised in East Malling. Fruity crisp and juicy
- 21 Kanzi – New variety crisp sweet and juicy
- 22 Cheerful Gold - A new variety grown at Staplehurst - look out for this in the future
- 23 Concorde – Comice x Conference – Eat crisp or ripen – either way almond sweet
- 24 Doyenne du Comice – Queen of the pears, deliciously sweet and very juicy
- 25 Conference – crisp sweet and nutty
- 26 Quince - Very fragrant, delicious for pies, cheese and jellies
- 27 A basket of the much in demand Beauty of Kent
- 28 A hand spun shawl produced by Audrey Durrant
- 29 A large Apple cake baked by Heidi on a date to be arranged
- 30 Apples for a year (value approx. £120). Either one basket from the Farm Shop or two bags from any Farmers Market that we attend, per week. Minimum Bid £50.

Pilgrims Hospices is a charity providing specialist palliative care free of charge to people in east Kent. We care for people with illnesses that cannot be cured including cancer, heart failure, respiratory conditions and neurological diseases.

Care is provided in patients' homes, via community programmes and within the hospices. Care is also extended to families and carers.

Just over 40% of people admitted to Pilgrims Hospices have their symptoms controlled so they can return home

Hospice care does not end when the patient has died, bereavement support is available for families

To keep delivering this care to those that need it the most, Pilgrims has to raise around £9 million each year. 75% of that funding comes from the local community. Over 80p in every £1 raised today is spent on patient care.
