The last 2 years Fruit Sale descriptions in my reports read "from every angle this years 103rd Hard Fruit Sale was by far the best to date" with last year's 104th Sale carrying the same description! You will also have read, loyal reader, to the swinging pendulum over the various earlier reports!! Well ..... the pendulum swung with an unparalled vengeance in this year's Sale for quality, clean crops of Bramley which had "nil" demand. The overhang of last year's Bramley still in store unsold, combined with a sluggish demand for volume sales of Bramley over the last 9 months, snuffed out at a stroke any flickering interest there may have been for Bramley. A very worrying and sombre outlook for the coming season.

In complete contrast you will see from the enclosed averages and sale highlights that good quality Dessert Apples \& Pears were keenly sought by our selective buyers, resulting in some excellent prices being paid for our grower vendors-all sales at the risk of the Purchasers on the fall of the hammer with full payment following two weeks later. Undoubtedly early money for top fruit crops this year will prove to be the best net prices returned to growers before further harvesting and storage costs are incurred.

The early market reports of demand and prices do not give confidence for increased demand and re-turns-let us hope that the pendulum swings-yet again-in favour of the UK growers and producers.

Time will tell !!

As predicted the pendulum swung from last year's exceptionally high Bramley prices in favour of good Cox crops to give a top sale price of $£ 5.60$ per bushel for Queen Cox and $£ 4.72$ per bushel for quality Bramley. Last year's delighted Auctioneer was equally pleased to see a fast trade and good demand for quality well grown Dessert and Bramley crops alike - a deserving financial return to the many Vendors for delivering quality. Hail was prevalent over the two months or so prior to the sale and left its unfortunate effect on crop value. A strong demand was generated by local grower buyers and packers to give an overall sale average of $£ 1,485$ per acre and $£ 3.22$ per bushel for Dessert crops, and $£ 1,529$ per acre and $£ 3.11$ per bushel for Culinary apples. Pear crop demand was only steady to average $£ 791$ per acre and $£ 2.57$ per bushel.

The above trend is clear for increasing demand and prices achieved for best quality well farmed Culinary and Dessert crops - with Pears remaining steady! As this report is written some 10 days after the sale, the mixture of hot weather and heavy rain should ensure the crops size well and reward the buyers!

Looking back in our 1994 Sale Report the Top Ten Culinary averaged $£ 770$ pa and $£ 1.82$ per bushel, the Top Ten Dessert Orchards averaged $£ 1,004$ pa and $£ 3.20$ per bushel, and the Top Three Pear Orchards $£ 625$ pa and $£ 4.50$ per bushel.
In this year's Sale of the 576 acres catalogued in 81 Lots, 52 Lots sold under the hammer and shortly after - giving an overall success rate of $64 \%$.
